Unfinished Business-

c) Vice President Baldauf will prioritize what need to be done vs what does not. Curbs that need replaced. Will check every 30 days, as part of committee and duties.

Fire Company- Having problems with atv, and other utvs in alleys traveling at high rate of speed on snow covered roads. State to handle sign out front, in phases. Looking for ways to stop traffic in front so emergency vehicles can leave station without roadway being blocked due to traffic light. Would like help from Boro with funds, and promotion of events.

Fire co asks for donation help for insurance costs. Council agreed to pay the outstanding amount due upon presentation of invoice, then provide anything above as needed to meet the \$14,000 for the year. Currently seeking the \$11,309 for the insurance invoice. This was a motion presented by Councilwoman Kim, second by Councilwoman Susan, motion passed.
